PE and Sports premium Funding is being provided by the Department for Education, Health and Culture and Media and Sport, to improve the provision of physical education and sport in primary school.

Their vision that 'All pupils leaving Primary School are Physically Literate and have the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip for a healthy, active lifestyle and lifelong participation in Physical activity and Sport'.

At DCINS we will continue to employ a **PE Sports Leader and Development Specialist**, Mrs Jayne Wassell (an experienced Sports specialist teacher) to take the lead responsibility for developing a programme to support the government's initiative to achieve **self sustaining** improvement in the quality of PE and Sport in Primary Schools.

PE Sports Leader and Development Specialist will:

- Develop the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity in order to kick-start healthy active lifestyles.
- Raise the profile of PE and Sport across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.
- Increase the confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and Sport
- To provide a broader experience of a range of Sports and activities offered to all pupils.
