We hope that you have had a lovely summer holiday and are ready for an exciting Autumn term. We would like to welcome our new Nursery children and their families—we hope that you enjoy your time with us.

## Weather!

Please make sure that your child is prepared for all seasons!

Your child will need;

- A sunhat/sun cream if the weather is hot
- A waterproof coat or mac [if possible with a hood] if it is wet
- Wellies [named, please] to keep in Nursery
- A change of clothes in their back pack [just in case!].



## Bringing your child in to Nursery in the morning

1. Help your child to find their peg and take their self registration teddy label off their peg.
2. Help your child to hang up their coat and bag.
3. Give your child's letter bag to Miss Baynton and let her know if there are any messages.
4. Help your child to hang the self registration teddy on a hook.
5. Remind your child to go to the toilet [Mrs Monteiro will be there to help in the toilets].
6. Settle your child with an activity and then say "goodbye".



If your child is distressed, an adult will come to support you. It is always kinder to say "goodbye" to your child and then leave straightaway. Children always calm down very quickly once their adult has gone. If you hover or stand and wave at the window, it will only upset both you and your child even more.

If you are worried, phone the office a little bit later and they will let you know that your child has settled and is fine. If we have any concerns, we will always call you.



## What are we learning in Nursery?

This half term, our themes are "Ourselves" and "Our Families".

*Please could your child bring in some photos of their family, pets etc to talk about and to display on their section of the Learning Wall. We will return the photos when they are taken down.*

Your child is in either Blue group or Red group and they will have a section on the Learning Wall display boards that is theirs.

## Tapestry Accounts
