Can you draw a self portrait?

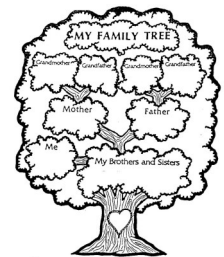


What is your favourite hobby?
