Dear Parents/Carers,

COVID - 19

Please see the guidance below as advised by the DFE:

- It is essential that your child does not attend school if they have symptoms of covid-19. These symptoms include a persistent cough with a high temperature or loss of taste/smell. Other symptoms are possible and may need to be checked with a doctor.
- If your child or someone in your household is experiencing symptoms, they must have a test by self-referring via http://self-referral.test-for-coronavirus.service.gov.uk The test must be completed within 3 days of first having the symptoms.
- We kindly ask that if you receive a positive test, that you notify the school as soon as possible by calling 01362 692727 or emailing office@dereham.norfolk.sch.uk
- We will notify you if there is a confirmed case of Covid-19 within your class bubble.
- If there is a confirmed case of Covid-19, the school will take advice from Public Health England and notify you of the actions required.
