Literacy:

Read back your questions created yesterday to interview a member of your house. Take your list of questions to the person and ask to begin your interview. When they respond with answers, you must note down their response. Once complete, look back at your notes. You must now rewrite their answers in full sentences using cursive handwriting, correct punctuation and spellings. You will need to turn their answers into full sentences that make sense e.g. your note might say 'red' as the answer to favourite colour so you would need to write this as a full sentence such as 'Ben's favourite colour is red.'

Maths: 2D shape pattern making

Now that you have explored, named and identified 2D shapes and their properties, we would like you to create shape patterns using a range of shapes.

Theme: Art
