With an adult's help, can you make chocolate dinosaur nest eggs.

You will need:

Chocolate

Cornflakes/rice crispies

Mini chocolate eggs.

1. Melt some chocolate - Make sure your grown-up is there helping.
2. Add some rice crispies/cornflakes into the melted chocolate and stir until all of the cereal is covered.
3. Spoon the mixture into cupcake cases.
4. Add some mini chocolate eggs to our nest.
5. Leave somewhere cold to allow them to set.
