**Literacy:** *The three little pigs*

Read through your writing from yesterday to remind yourself which part of the story you got up to. Today we are going to continue to write our story. Use your story map to help you remember the order of the story and to use your labelled key words. Remember to think carefully about spelling suffix words.



**Maths:** *Patterns with 3D shapes*

We would like you to create shape patterns using a range of 3D shapes.

## Phonics

Phoneme spotter - oo, ue, ew, u-e, ou

### Make a cool hot air balloon

You will need:

Bowl, balloon spoon, glue, newspaper, cube and wool.



1. Blow up the balloon until it is huge.
2. Mix up the glue in a bowl. Use a spoon.
3. Put strips of newspaper into the glue then smooth them over the balloon.
4. Leave to dry then pop the balloon.
5. Attach the cube with the wool.
6. Paint any hue. Blue looks super cool.
