Writing:

To think about the plot of your story.

We have done lots of hard work in the planning stages of our story, today we are going to think about what happens to our characters in our story. We are going to use a story mountain to show what happens in the beginning, the middle and the end of our story. We are going to write a short sentence explaining what might happen during the plot. (please see video on Tapestry explaining how the story mountain works and a completed piece of work).

Remember when you write your short sentences we would like to see capital letters for the start of sentences, names of people and places, finger spaces between words and full stops.
