

Weather watching

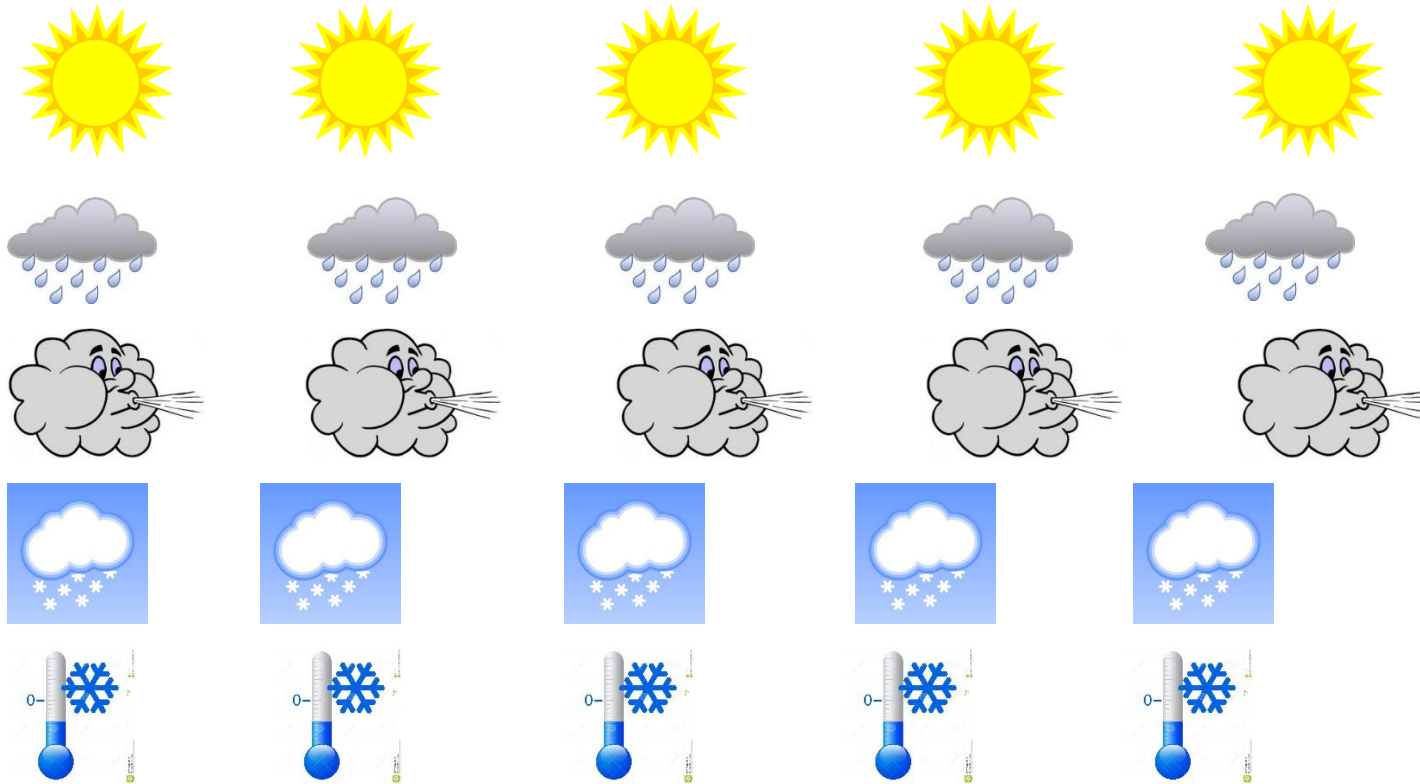
Use the chart on the next page to keep a record of the weather for one week.
