Pasta photo frame craft activity

Materials you will need:


• 2 pieces of card (cereal box card is good for this)

18cm x 14cm

- Pasta bows
- · PVA Glue
- Either gold or silver spray paint or acrylic paint/ paint brush
- A photograph to fit the frame
- Small amount of ribbon or string
- · Sticky tape.

What you need to do

- 1. Cut two pieces of card from your cereal box.
- 2. Take ONE of the pieces and cut out the middle so that you have a 3cm frame (see picture below not drawn to scale)



3. Thickly apply PVA glue to the sides and place the pasta so that it overlaps all the way around



- 4. Allow the glue to dry
- 5. When the glue is dry either take the frame outside, place on some newspaper underneath and spray it with gold or silver paint or paint very carefully using acrylic paint making sure all of the pasta is covered.



- 6. When the paint is dry select a suitable photograph or draw a picture and stick on the back of the frame.
- 7. Glue the second piece of card to the back of the photo to make the picture secure.
- 8. Attach a small amount of string or ribbon with some tape so that the picture can be hung up.
