Once you have drawn them, can you label each animal?

Maths

Can you draw two boats? On the first boat, draw some animals. Then, draw some more animals on the other boat. Can you write the number sentence to match how many animals you have drawn?

Creative

Can you make a boat that floats?

Some ideas: You could use tin foil or an apple to make your boat?

Once you have made your boat, test it in some water and tell your grown up what you notice.





Extra: Can you add coins on top of your boat and pretend these coins are animals.

How many animals can ride on your ark before it sinks?
