## Literacy: Pirate punch recipe

Yesterday we created a list of ingredients and equipment for making 'Ahoy matey punch'. Today we are going to write instructions for the beginning to the method. Today we'd like you to create your own pirate treasure map.

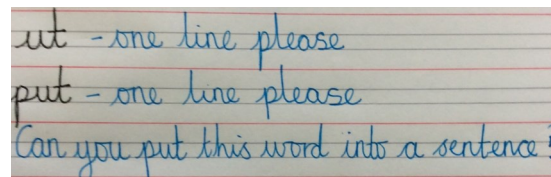


Your treasure map must have:

## Handwriting: 'ut'

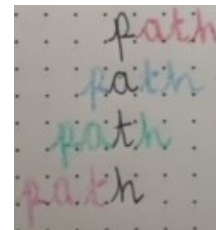
