## Maths

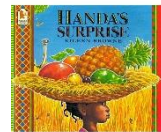


Play a game of 'show me'. Ask your grown up to say a number for you to show them using your fingers. Can you then tell them how many more you would need to make 10?

Can you then write down the correct number sentence?

## Phonics

Listen to the story 'Handa's surprise' on Tapestry.

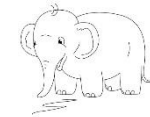


Then watch today's 'hold a sentence' phonics video and have a go at writing a sentence about Handa's surprise. Remember that a sentence needs a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop.

Once you have written your sentence, can you draw a picture to go with it?

## Creative

Can you play a game of 'Pictionary' with your grown up?



Think of an animal and then you have 1 minute to draw that animal. Can your grown up guess what animal you have drawn?

Then you could swap and guess what animal your grown up has drawn for you.

Do you know any interesting facts about the animals you have drawn?

## PE - balancing

For PE today, you are going to pretend to be a train.

1. Can you crawl around tooting like a train, moving opposite arms and legs?
2. Can you now move forwards and backwards, standing up and lifting your knees high, while keeping in a straight line like a train on a train track?
