BIG QUESTION: What does it mean to follow God?

Yesterday we looked at the narrative of 'The Calling of the Fishermen'. We learnt about Jesus' followers, his disciples.

Today we are going to think more deeply about what a disciple is and what it means to be one.

Why did the disciples want to follow Jesus?

Why were the disciples so important to Jesus?

Have a discussion with your adults about these questions, express your own thoughts and feelings about them. Think about the relationship Jesus had with his disciples and what their role was on behalf of Jesus.
