Vocabulary: Zoo keeper

What do you think the word /zoo keeper/ means? Research the word with your grown-up.

Fine Motor

Can you draw yourself as a zoo keeper? Practise writing your name underneath your drawing. Remember to write the first letter of your name as a capital letter as names always start with a capital letter.

Maths

Today we are focusing on the number 10. Can you collect 10 objects? How many different ways can you make the number 10? E.g 5+45=10

You could draw a lady bird again to help you.

Can you write down the number sentences that you make?

Can you balance on one leg for 10 seconds?



Top tip: Keep your arms out straight and keep looking at one object.

Phonics

Watch the Phonics video on Tapestry. Practice writing the grapheme /ow/. Remember to join the letters together because it is a digraph. Can you write the word to match the picture?



Once you have practiced the grapheme, watch the rest of the phonics video and have a go at writing a sentence. Remember that a sentence needs a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop.
