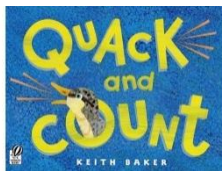
Maths

Today in maths we will be learning about combining (adding) two groups.

Listen to the story 'Quack and Count' on Tapestry.

Some of the pages will have the text hidden.

Can you write the number sentence for the amount of ducks on the page and then work out how many ducks are on that page altogether before the answer is revealed?



For example,
Amount of ducks on the left side of the page + amount of ducks on the right side of the page = how many ducks there are altogether.

Phonics

Watch the Phonics video on Tapestry. Practice writing the grapheme /ar/. Remember to join the letters together because it is a digraph. Can you write the word to match the picture?



Can you think of a sentence about the picture and write it down? Remember to use a capital letter at the start of your sentence, fingers spaces and a full stop at the end.
