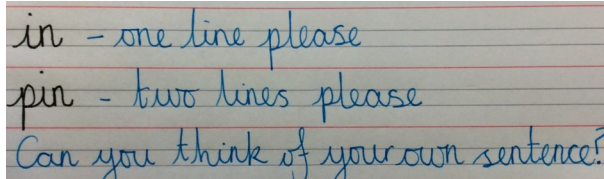
Theme:

Handwriting: 'in'

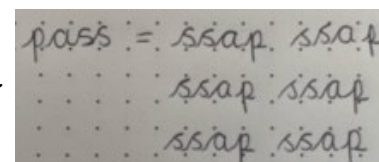
Please take a look at today's handwriting practice photo on Tapestry.

Look at the alternative spelling of the 'or' phoneme as 'al'. Sound out and blend the following words: talk, walk, wall, calling, beanstalk. Next segment and spell the following words; fall, stalk, ball, talking, walk, wall. Put the sound buttons under each word. Read the sentence 'The beanstalk was tall.' Read the tricky words could, would, should.
