Literacy: Pirate punch recipe

This week we have designed and created our own recipe for a pirates punch. Today we are going to read through our recipe and edit to improve. We are going to check for any mistakes such as spellings or missing punctuation. We are then going to see if we can improve our writing of the method. Could you add adverbs to your instructions or adjectives to make it more interesting? Follow the video on tapestry to see an example of how to edit your recipe.

Maths: To compare durations of time

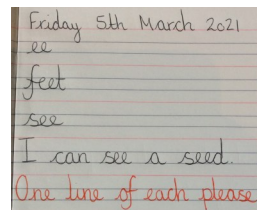
Today we are going to compare durations of time. What does the word 'duration' mean? Please watch today's maths video via Tapestry. Activities 1, 2 and 3 are on page 3 of this document if you wish to print this page off (you do not have to, this is just an option).

PE: Hopscotch

Hop scotch forwards and backwards. If you have chalk, set up a hopscotch outside on the path in a safe area. Practice hopscotching forwards first. Hop, jump, hop, jump. Then practise starting at the top of the hopscotch and travel backwards, try looking over your shoulder to see if any obstructions are in the way. Focus on your footwork at the same time. Travelling backwards might take a little while to master, but practise makes perfect!

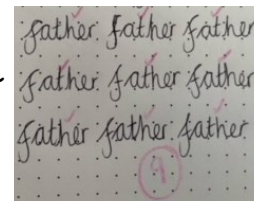
