This half term we are focussing on developing vocabulary. This is a key skill that will help your child in their early learning development. Each week the key vocabulary for our theme "What happens when we sleep?" will be put on to Tapestry so you can encourage your child to use these words at home. Also we have put an information sheet on to Tapestry containing games and ideas that can help your child to develop a wide vocabulary.
