### **COVID - 19**

### Please see the guidance below as advised by the DFE:-

- It is essential that your child does not attend school if they have symptoms of covid-19. These symptoms include a persistent cough with a high temperature or loss of taste/smell. Other symptoms are possible and may need to be checked with a doctor.
- If your child or someone in your household is experiencing symptoms, they must have a test by self-referring via <a href="http://self-referral.test-for-coronavirus.service.gov.uk">http://self-referral.test-for-coronavirus.service.gov.uk</a> The test must be completed within 3 days of first having the symptoms.
- We kindly ask that if you receive a positive test, that you notify the school as soon as
  possible by calling 01362 692727 or emailing office@dereham.norfolk.sch.uk. At
  weekends only, please email Mrs Futers directly at head@dereham.norfolk.sch.uk for
  positive cases.
- We will notify you if there is a confirmed case of Covid-19 within the school and if your child is a close contact
- If there is a confirmed case of Covid-19, the school will take advice from Public Health England and notify you of the actions required.
- If your child is over 5 years old and is identified as a close contact it is advised that they take a LFD for 7 days following contact. This has helped to identify cases and reduce spread. We thank you for your continued support.

### <u>Registration - Doors Close at 9.05am</u>

Registration is open from 8:45am until 9:05am.

Any child arriving late, but before 9:15am will be marked late (L on the register).

If a child arrives after 9:15am they will be marked as 'U' —Registration closed. This is regarded as an unauthorised absence unless an explanation is given and accepted as grounds for authorising the late arrival.

Late arrivals - Children arriving late must come into school by the office entrance giving a reason for the lateness. The secretary will amend the registers accordingly. Arriving late can cause disruption to your child's daily routines.

Afternoon registration will take place at 1pm and the registers will close at 1.10pm.

All children collected after 3.15pm will be entered into the late book in the office. A reason for late collection must be given.

## School Dinners/Snacks

### <u>Parking</u>

Please **DO NOT** park along Washbridge on the single and double yellow lines. Not only is parking along Washbridge illegal and could result in a fine, the absence of cars ensures the safety of the children at the start and the end of the school day. Parking along Washbridge reduces visibility for those walking through the Churchyard, in addition to the congestion that extra traffic provides. We have sought support from the Police and Enforcement Agents from the Highways Division who will be making spot checks. Please note the school is not responsible for the enforcement of parking around the school. We are aware that residents of Washbridge have made complaints to the authorities so please bear this in mind. Should you have any issues with regards to the parking and congestion please report this to the police.



### **Emergency School Closure**

### LA Guidelines for Emergency

At times it may be necessary to close school for various reasons including:

- Severe weather, eq snow
- Unsuitable accommodation, eg no power/heating

If we experience extreme weather conditions the school will endeavor to remain open. However, as none of our teaching staff live locally, the condition of surrounding areas will need to be considered in our judgement to close the school.

### Morning Closure before school is due to start

If there has been heavy snow on the previous day/evening and it is deemed necessary to close the school, parents may obtain the closure information from the following sources:

- Listen to Radio Norfolk or Heart FM
- . Check your mobile; a text will be sent
- Check the Emergency School Closure website at: <a href="www.schools.norfolk.gov.uk">www.schools.norfolk.gov.uk</a> Click on Emergency School Closures

Every effort is made to inform the LA and radio stations, though as you can appreciate when so many Headteachers are trying to also make contact, this is not always possible. If you hear that other Dereham schools are either open or closed, please do **NOT** assume that we are the same.

### Closure During the Day

If we need to carry out an emergency school closure during the day we will text all parents/carers or telephone. **Please ensure that we have up to date emergency contact** numbers.

In the event of extreme weather conditions eg: heavy snowfall, please do not hesitate to come and collect your child/ren if you are anxious about the state of the roads.
