At DCINS we employ Mrs Ella Gauntlett as our PE Lead who takes responsibility for developing a programme to support the government's initiative to 'develop an enjoyment of sport and physical activity, and promote a healthy lifestyle in children' that is sustainable for the school and improves outcomes for all children using the Jasmine PE scheme and Real PE. PE Sports Leader will: Support teaching staff in embedding a more in depth P.E curriculum which develops the children physically, mentally and encourages inclusive competition.
