Maths and Literacy

During Autumn I, the children will be basing their literacy learning around an alternative story of Little Red Riding Hood. They will be concentrating on sentence structure and the correct use of punctuation. In reading comprehension, children will take part in role play to act out the story and will share their ideas and opinions of the book. In Maths the children will focus on place value, addition and subtraction.

In year two, we will be promoting spelling and practising the common exception words for year two daily. Please practise these whenever possible at home to support your child's spelling. If unsure of the common exception words, please take a look at our website.
