<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Children would have explored playing with different technological toys such as phones, laptops and tablets. These won't be working devices but allow the children to pretend play with them to explore what they do and how people use them.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• During Spring 2, Summer 1 and Summer 2, the children will be introduced to 'Mini Mash'. They will then be using the iPad to complete different activities with adult guidance and will therefore need to know how to use technology carefully and safely.</li> </ul>

safety rules e.g. not to walk around holding the iPads, to hold the technology with both hands, to use an iPad with a grown up.

- Children to be introduced to their class iPad licence. This needs to be on display for the children to see when they are using the iPad with a grown up.
- Children to be able to talk about how we should look after our school and home technology devices.

### Key vocabulary

- *iPad* - A tablet.
- *iPad licence* - A laminated iPad with iPad rules on one side. Each child has their own signed iPad licence which they must have when using an iPad.
- *Rules* - An instruction we need to follow.
- *Safe*

### Common misconceptions

- Children may have seen their grown ups moving around while holding a phone or iPad. Children should be taught that at school they must sit down with it.

### Memorable first hand experiences

- Safer Internet Day afternoon (Date to be confirmed annually depending on when the day is being celebrated that year).

### Opportunities for communication

- Children will be encouraged to talk about how we look after the technology in school and at home e.g. the iPad.

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## Reasonable adjustments for pupils with SEND

### Communication and Interaction

- Make sure the children are using the correct equipment for them.
- Consider headphones to support the child to hear.
- Have someone available to read any text that is on the screen.

### Cognition and Learning

- Consider adjusting the brightness and colour so they can see the screen more easily.
- Have someone available to read any text that is on the screen.
- Shorter steps given at appropriate time.
- Simpler logins.
- Adult to support with logging in.
- Print out which the different functions and tools on.
- Step by step guide printed out for them to refer to.

### Social, Emotional and Mental health

- Timer so they understand when they will need to log off.
- Clear boundaries.
- Online safety instructions made clear.

### Sensory and Physical

- Larger text/equipment.
- Print offs instead of screen time.
- Appropriate desk, chair, keyboard and mouse.
