Get to know me:

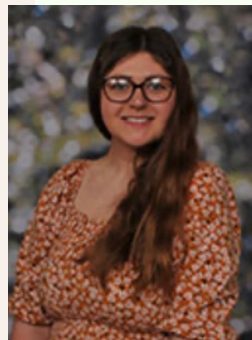


- My favourite animal is an elephant and I love a trip to the theatre. I also like a lot of foods beginning with C, chocolate, crisps and chips!
